

## Diploma Cosmetology Programme of Study

The Diploma in Cosmetology introduces students to the field of cosmetology and prepares them for employment in the beauty industry. Students acquire the skills and techniques necessary to provide a variety of services for the hair such as cutting and styling, chemical and colouring services and braiding and weaving. Students also learn to care for the face and nails, perform manicures and pedicures and apply basic make-up. Students complete a 160-hour practicum which prepares them for work in an established enterprise or to open and operate their own business.
