### PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

The Special Interest Certificate (Level III) in Esthetics prepares students to enter the workforce as self-employed estheticians, esthetician assistants or cosmetics salespersons. Students are introduced to treatments, therapies, products and procedures that help care for and maintain the skin. They learn to recommend and apply cleansing procedures and perform facial treatments including facial massages and masks. Emphasis is on client consultations, skill development, hygienic work environments and professional ethics.
